Warm greetings from Redemptorist Development Organization.

Redemptorist Development Organization, guided by Catholic Social Teaching and the values of human dignity, justice, and solidarity, is committed to advancing the development of vulnerable children and youth through education, empowerment, and advocacy.

We are currently supporting 25 vulnerable learners from Chiweshe rural who successfully completed Grade Seven and are now enrolled in Form One at Marongwe Secondary School. Despite severe socio-economic challenges, including child-headed households and extreme poverty, they achieved strong academic results (8–25 units). For these learners, education is a pathway to dignity, opportunity, and breaking the cycle of generational poverty.

Through the support of well-wishers, we secured school fees and essential learning needs for 2026. We are now seeking support to sustain their education for the next three years. The required support is **USD 62 per child per term, totaling USD 558 per child over three years, or USD 13,950 for all 25 learners.**

Your support will ensure uninterrupted education, safeguard future opportunities, and contribute to long-term community development. Subject to available resources, we aim to expand support to 50 or more learners as the need continues to grow.

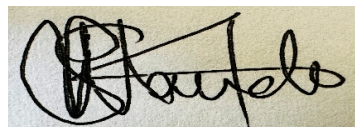
